

## **ORAL PRESENTATION GUIDELINES**

1. Please refer to the table below for presentation times:

*Keynote/Plenary/Industrial talks	30 minutes presentation
Invited talks (parallel session)	20 minutes presentation plus a maximum of 5 minutes discussion
Technical talks (parallel session)	10 minutes presentation plus a maximum of 5 minutes discussion

<sup>\*</sup>An optional up to 5 minutes of discussion will be allowed if there is an ample time.

- 2. Presentation materials should be either in PowerPoint format PPTX or PDF. Screen resolution with 4:3 aspect ratio. Videos should preferably be in WMV or MP4 format; use a standard codec. Please note that a speaker system is not provided by the organizer except for the Grand Ballroom.
- 3. All presentation materials and videos should be saved to a USB flash drive.
- 4. Laptop, projector and laser pointer will be provided by the organizer.
- 5. Participation certificate will be given after each presentation session.

## POSTER PRESENTATION GUIDELINES

- Posters should be put up to one hour before the poster session and removed by 04:30pm on the same day. The organizer will not be held liable for any loss and/or damage of the poster.
- 2. During the poster session, the presenters must stand next to their posters, so they can present their work and address questions from the delegates and a poster award judging panel. Each poster presentation will be evaluated by two independent judging panels for consideration of the "BEST PRESENTATION POSTER AWARD". Each presenter will be allotted up to 5 minutes to present their work to the judging panels.
- 3. Poster size is A1 portrait (W594mm x H841mm).
- 4. Material for attaching the poster will be supplied by the organizer.
- 5. Participation certificate can be collected at the registration desk after a poster session.
